



# The Fourth of July Tour

## West Bend to Green Bay July 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008



Our tour will begin at the Washington County Fairgrounds just South of West Bend. Please arrive at 8:00am on Friday July 4<sup>th</sup> so that we may depart promptly at 8:30am or join us along the way. Parking of trailers and tow vehicles will be permitted in the Fairgrounds parking lot in a designated area.

Once underway our route will take us around the West side of Lake Winnebago on some great "Model T Roads" and will include 3 of Wisconsin's "Rustic Roads". Our lunch stop will be in Winneconne at the "Fin 'N' Feather" right on the Wolf River.



In Green Bay, we will be staying at the Bay Motel and Family Restaurant, less than 1 mile from Lambeau Field. **(Please make your reservations soon if you are planning to go.)** All rooms are 1<sup>st</sup> floor and parking is right outside your room. The convenient on-site restaurant has good food at reasonable prices. Green Bay's all-day July 4<sup>th</sup> festival, in the middle of Downtown, is capped by a fireworks display at dusk. This should be visible from nearly anywhere in the Downtown area and we have the opportunity to drive in closer to see it.

On Saturday we have a reservation for a 9:00am Lambeau Field Stadium Tour! (We should be there at 8:30am.) It is a guided 1 hour tour and your **\$17.00** per person "combo" group rate ticket includes a visit to the Hall Of Fame afterwards. **This is the only fee that we are asking you to pay in advance, as we must pay in advance for the tour.** After our Hall of Fame visit we will have lunch at Curly's Pub in the Lambeau Field Atrium.



Next, you'll want to walk off some of that lunch. The National Railroad Museum is just the place to do that. As one of the oldest railroad museums in the country, the NRM exhibits a large collection of locomotives and railcars spanning more than a century of railroading. Our 2:00pm 45 minute guided tour will provide valuable insights into their collection, after which we are free to explore the buildings and grounds on our own. **Admission for our group members will be \$7.50 for adults and \$5.00 for children under 10, and can be purchased at the door that day.**



On Saturday evening we will have a short (30 minute) "Sunset Tour" which will take us on yet another of Wisconsin's Rustic roads, ending at a small dinner spot where you can purchase pizza, subs, chicken and freshly made ice-cream (if you are not too stuffed from lunch). On Sunday we will make our way back to West Bend along the East side of Lake Winnebago. The open road is calling...**JOIN US FOR SOME FUN!**
